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Documents required to apply for a Schengen Visa

- Visa application form. Fully completed and signed. Please refer to page 3-6 for the Schengen Visa Application Form.
- **Two recently taken color photos must be attached. Photo size: 35x45mm.** Both photos must be taken within the last three months, according to the visa photo requirements.
- A valid passport. Not older than 10 years, and it should valid for at least three more months beyond the date you plan to leave the Schengen area. And any older passports with visas on them.
- **Round trip reservation or itinerary.** It must include dates and flight numbers specifying entry and exit from the Schengen area.
- **Travel insurance policy**. A document that proves you have travel health insurance for the whole Schengen territory, with a minimum coverage of 30,000 euros in case of any medical emergency such as illnesses, accidents and even repatriation in case of death. The insurance company must be companies that are already approved by Schengen.
- **Proof of accommodation.** A document that shows where you will be accommodated throughout your stay in Schengen area such as hotel booking details.
- **Proof of financial means**. Evidence that you have enough money to support yourself financially throughout your stay in the Schengen area.
 - Original Personal bank statements of the applicant for last 6 months with the original stamp and signature of authorized signatory of the bank (Online Bank statements are not acceptable) and bank certificate (Saving account only). This is a mandatory statement. (Please note that as per Instructions received from Embassy of Spain, Company's Bank statements/ITR are not required even for a business trip at the time of Application Submission).
- Invitation Letter. Invitation letter issued by a Spanish Company in Spanish language or both in English and Spanish. Letters issued only in English will not be accepted. This will be an obligatory requirement. Spanish company /companies inviting the applicant, explaining the purpose of the present visit and the nature of existing commercial relationship.
- Proof of paid visa fee.

I am aware of and consent to the following: the collection of the data required by this application form and the taking of my photograph and, if applicable, the taking of fingerprints, are mandatory for the examination of the visa application; and any personal data concerning me which appear on the visa application form, as well as my fingerprints and my photograph will be supplied to the relevant authorities of the Member States and processed by those authorities, for the purposes of a decision on my visa application.

Such data as well as data concerning the decision taken on my application or a decision whether to annul, revoke or extend a visa issued will be entered into, and stored in the Visa Information System (VIS) for a maximum period of five years, during which it will be accessible to the visa authorities and the authorities competent for carrying out checks on visas at external borders and within the Member States, immigration and asylum authorities in the Member States for the purposes of verifying whether the conditions for the legal entry into, stay and residence on the territory of the Member States are fulfilled, of identifying persons who do not or who no longer fulfil these conditions, of examining an asylum application and of determining responsibility for such examination. Under certain conditions the data will be also available to designated authorities of the Member States and to Europol for the purpose of the prevention, detection and investigation of terrorist offences and of other serious criminal offences. In Spain, the authority responsible for processing the data is the consular post at which the visa was applied for.

I am aware that I have the right to obtain in any of the Member States notification of the data relating to me recorded in the VIS and of the Member State which transmitted the data, and to request that data relating to me which are inaccurate be corrected and that data relating to me processed unlawfully be deleted. At my express request, the authority examining my application will inform me of the manner in which I may exercise my right to check the personal data concerning me and have them corrected or deleted, including the related remedies according to the national law of the State concerned. I declare that to the best of my knowledge all particulars supplied by me are correct and complete. I am aware that any false statements will lead to my application being rejected or to the annulment of a visa already granted and may also render me liable to prosecution under the law of the Member State which deals with the application.

I undertake to leave the territory of the Member States before the expiry of the visa, if granted. I have been informed that possession of a visa is only one of the prerequisites for entry into the European territory of the Member States. The mere fact that a visa has been granted to me does not mean that I will be entitled to compensation if I fail to comply with the relevant provisions of Article 6(1) of Regulation (EC) No 399/2016 (Schengen Borders Code) and I am therefore refused entry. The prerequisites for entry will be checked again on entry into the European territory of the Member States.
