Documents required to apply for a Schengen Visa

- **Visa application form.** Fully completed and signed. Please refer to page 3-6 for the Schengen Visa Application Form.
- **Two recently taken color photos must be attached. Photo size: 35x45mm.** Both photos must be taken within the last three months, according to the visa photo requirements.
- A valid passport. Not older than 10 years, and it should valid for at least three more months beyond the date you plan to leave the Schengen area. And any older passports with visas on them.
- Round trip reservation or itinerary. It must include dates and flight numbers specifying entry and exit from the Schengen area.
- Travel insurance policy. A document that proves you have travel health insurance for the whole Schengen territory, with a minimum coverage of 30,000 euros in case of any medical emergency such as illnesses, accidents and even repatriation in case of death. The insurance company must be companies that are already approved by Schengen.
- **Proof of accommodation.** A document that shows where you will be accommodated throughout your stay in Schengen area such as hotel booking details.
- **Proof of financial means**. Evidence that you have enough money to support yourself financially throughout your stay in the Schengen area.
 - Original Personal bank statements of the applicant for last 6 months with the original stamp and signature of authorized signatory of the bank (Online Bank statements are not acceptable) and bank certificate (Saving account only). This is a mandatory statement.
- **Invitation Letter.** Invitation letter issued by a Czech Republic based company. This will be an obligatory requirement for a business visa. Czech Republic company /companies inviting the applicant, explaining the purpose of the present visit and the nature of existing commercial relationship.
- Proof of paid visa fee.
